
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED

That the defendants, their officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys and distributors and all persons in active concert and participation or privity with them, be and they are hereby are permanently restrained and enjoined from any manner, either directly or indirectly: affixing or utilizing, in connection with the manufacture, promotion, distribution, sale and/or other exploitation of the plaintiff's symbols or origin, consisting of i) the trademark consisting in whole or in part of the word URUSA, alone or in combination with any other word, image, picture or the like, or ii) any packages, labels, boxes, containers or the like, a dark background with gold outlines and the depiction of a bear of iii) any

imitation or combination of any of the above likely to be confused therewith, including but not limited to the use of such confusingly similar imitations currently being used by the defendants and/or their products that are associated with, sponsored by, and/or otherwise connected with the plaintiff or their products in any manner.
