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\$3,231.69 as calculated to 4/6/98 computed at the rate of ½% above published prime rate, as qualified by Citibank, N. A., liquidated damages in the sum of \$15,124.00 reasonable attorney's fees in the sum of \$2,220.00 and costs in the sum of \$195.65, for a total of \$96,391.36 all awarded pursuant to 29 U.S.C. §1132(g) (2).
