The Court has ORDERED that the MDC and MCC respond to concerns about the institutions' response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Inmate orderlies continue to clean the common areas of all housing units, and inmates have been instructed to continue to wipe down and sanitize their living quarters.

Please be advised that the following numbers constitute a running tally, which began on March 13, 2020.

With regard to the numbers as of March 9, 2021, for MDC:

- Inmates Tested: 6,885
- Inmates Positive: 390
- Inmates in Isolation: 3
- Inmates Recovered: 387
- Inmates Hospitalized: 0
- Inmate Deaths: 1
- Inmates Vaccinated: 196¹

¹ This number reflects the inmates that received the first dose of the vaccine. Some inmates have not received the second dose because they had permanently left the institution prior to the time the second dose was received at the

- Staff Positive: 111
- Staff Recovered: 104
- Staff Hospitalized: 2
- Staff Vaccinated: 110²

With regard to the numbers as of March 9, 2021 for MCC:

- Inmates Tested: 3,289
- Inmates Positive: 87
- Inmates Hospitalized: 1
- Inmates Deaths: 0
- Inmates Vaccinated: 53
- Staff Positive: 61
- Staff Recovered: 60
- Staff Hospitalized: 0
- Staff Vaccinated: 84
