Dear Magistrate Judge Pollak:

We represent Defendants in connection with the above-referenced matter. This letter is submitted jointly on behalf of the Parties.

Yesterday morning, a Scheduling Order was issued by Judge Weinstein scheduling for July 28, 2010 argument on Plaintiffs' pending motions for leave to amend their complaint and for conditional certification and notice to the proposed class. (A copy of the referenced Scheduling Order, docketed on June 24, 2010, is attached.) The Scheduling Order directs the Parties to agree on a schedule for further briefing on Plaintiffs' motions, and that all briefs must be submitted no later than one week before the hearing (July 21, 2010). During a telephone conference on June 9, 2010, Your Honor had ordered that Plaintiffs' file their motion for conditional certification by June 18, 2010 (which they did), and that Defendants' response be filed on June 25, 2010. Your Honor also directed that the depositions of the named Plaintiffs be conducted prior to July 9, 2010.

In light of Judge Weinstein's Scheduling Order setting the date for oral argument (July 28, 2010) and deadline for submissions (July 21, 2010), the Parties jointly respectfully request the following schedule: (1) Defendants' time to file their opposition to Plaintiffs' conditional certification motion be extended from June 25, 2010 to July 12, 2010; (2) Defendants' time to file an opposition to Plaintiffs' motion to amend be set for July 12, 2010 as well, and (3) Plaintiffs' replies, if any, to Defendants' oppositions be due July 21, 2010. The

Parties further request that the deadline for Defendants to conduct the depositions of the named Plaintiffs (as well as the proposed additional named Plaintiff) be extended to July 12, 2010.




