Dear Judges Raggi, Lynch, and Irizarry:

We represent the Senate Majority Defendants—New York State Senators Dean G. Skelos and Michael F. Nozzolio, and LATFOR member Welquis R. Lopez. We write to provide an update to the Court on the status of DOJ preclearance and the *Cohen v. Cuomo* state court proceeding

Today, the U.S. Department of Justice, Civil Rights Division, informed us that it has precleared the 2012 redistricting plan for the New York State Senate pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1973c. The DOJ's letter, which is attached hereto, referred to the State of New York's preclearance submission "as it relates to the increase in the number of senators from 62 to 63 and provides for the redistricting plan for the State Senate of the State of New York," and stated that "the Attorney General does not interpose any objection to the specified changes."

Also, the Court of Appeals of the State of New York heard oral argument yesterday in the *Cohen v. Cuomo* proceeding in which petitioners challenge the constitutionality of the legislation fixing the size of the New York State Senate at 63 seats in this redistricting cycle.

We will provide further updates to the Court as developments warrant.

Dear Mr. Carvin:

This refers to Chapter 16 (S.6696-A.9525) (2012), insofar as it relates to the increase in the number of senators from 62 to 63 and provides for the redistricting plan for the State Senate of the State of New York, submitted to the Attorney General pursuant to Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, 42 U.S.C. 1973c. We received your submission on March 16, 2012; additional information was received on April 10, 2012.

The Attorney General does not interpose any objection to the specified changes. However, we note that Section 5 expressly provides that the failure of the Attorney General to object does not bar subsequent litigation to enjoin the enforcement of the changes. Procedures for the Administration of Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, 28 C.F.R. 51.41.

Because the status of this submission is before the United States District Court for the District of Columbia in *State of New York v. United States*, 1:12-cv-00413 (D.D.C.) (three-judge court), and the United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York in *Favors v. Cuomo*, No. 11-cv-5632 (E.D.N.Y.) (three-judge court), we are providing the Court and counsel of record with a copy of this letter.
