Important Message from EDNY and SDNY - Action is Required.

NextGen CM/ECF will require you to upgrade your PACER account before October 9th if you have not already done so. You will have to link your PACER and CM/ECF accounts on or after October 9th.

On October 9, 2018, the Eastern and Southern Districts of New York will upgrade their CM/ECF systems to NextGen CM/ECF (NextGen). This requires filers to take the following steps to prepare for NextGen in order to continue to electronically <u>file:</u>;

1 Before October 9, 2018, upgrade your PACER account at https://www.pacer.gov, if you have not already done so. Each filer must have a unique individual PACER account. Shared PACER accounts will not work with NextGen. (Please note, PACER accounts created after August 11, 2014, are already upgraded accounts); 2 Beginning October 9, 2018, you must link each of your CM/ECF accounts to your PACER account in order to file.

Failure to complete these steps will prevent online filing after NextGen goes live on October 9th, 2018.
