A Mediator's Ethical Responsibility in Cases Involving Sexual Harassment

When a mediator discovers that a party to a potential mediation is allegedly a victim or perpetrator of sexual harassment, how might that impact the mediator's duty to maintain confidentiality and to protect party selfdetermination? What role, if any, should the mediator have in promoting accountability and transparency in our society with respect to sexual harassment? How should mediators who have experienced sexual harassment themselves deal with impartiality in their role as a neutral? In this interactive workshop, we explore the negotiation between a mediator's ethical duties and society's interest in preventing sexual harassment. In addition, we discuss how mediators can better accommodate the long-lasting psychological effects sexual harassment can have on survivors. This workshop will provide a forum for experienced mediators and advocates to discuss best practices and to understand the mediator's ethical responsibility in sexual harassment cases.
