this District have revealed that three grand juries sitting in the District will likely be able to muster a quorum prior to July 13, 2020, and that five other grand juries currently empaneled in this District remain unable to muster quorums through at least July 10, 2020.

Upon consideration of the exigent circumstances arising from the continuing public health emergency in this District, and in order to continue to protect public health, and prevent the spread of COVID-19, it is "unreasonable to expect return and filing of [an] indictment within the period specified in section 3161(b)." 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(B)(iii). See also 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A). As such, it is

ORDERED that Administrative Order 2020-20 is hereby amended to further toll the 30day time period for filing an indictment under 18 U.S.C. § 3161(b) from July 1, 2020 until July 13, 2020.
