MARSHAL

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has declared a national emergency, and the Governor of New York has banned mass gatherings throughout the state and taken other actions in response to the spread of the COVID-19 virus, a novel coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and other public health authorities have advised the taking of precautions to reduce the possibility of exposure to the virus and slow the spread of the disease; it is hereby

ORDERED that, in all cases filed on or after March 18, 2020, and in which under ordinary circumstances the Court would, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(c), appoint the United States Marshal or a deputy marshal to make service, any requirement that the Marshal accomplish service is suspended, and the time from March 18, 2020 through April 27, 2020 is, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(m), excluded from the 90-day period to accomplish service.
