SERVICE OF PROCESS BY THE
UNITED STATES MARSHAL

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has continued to have an extraordinary impact on this District and the operations of this Court, as set forth in this Court's prior Administrative Orders Nos. 2020-06, 2020-11, 2020-15, 2020-15-1, and 2020-20; and

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 2020-12 ordered that, in all cases filed on or after March 18, 2020, and in which under ordinary circumstances the Court would, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(c), appoint the United States Marshal or a deputy marshal to make service, any requirement that the Marshal accomplish service was suspended, and the time from March 18, 2020 through April 27, 2020 was, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(m), excluded from the 90-day period to accomplish service; it is

ORDERED that Administrative Order 2020-12 is hereby amended to further suspend, in all cases filed on or after March 18, 2020 and in which, under ordinary circumstances, the Court would, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(c), appoint the United States Marshal or a deputy marshal to make service, any requirement that the Marshal accomplish service *nunc pro tunc* from June 15, 2020 until further order of this Court; and it is

ORDERED that the time from April 27, 2020 until further order of this Court stating otherwise is excluded from the 90-day period to accomplish service, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(m), *nunc pro tunc* from June 15, 2020.
