Pursuant to the authority conferred by 28 U.S.C. § 631, *et seq.*, and the further authority granted by the Judicial Conference of the United States, and

Whereas a Merit Selection Panel appointed by the Court, after public notice of the impending appointment of a magistrate judge, an application period and interview by the Panel, designated a list of qualified candidates to the Court for consideration, and

Whereas the Board of Judges approved the selection of Peggy Cross-Goldenberg as a United States Magistrate Judge on March 4, 2025, it is now

ORDERED that Peggy Cross-Goldenberg is hereby appointed to serve as a full-time United States Magistrate Judge for the Eastern District of New York, at a salary fixed by the Judicial Conference, and shall hold and discharge the duties of the office for a term of eight years from the effective date of this appointment, January 5, 2026, subject to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 631(i), unless sooner relieved. Prior to the commencement of such duties, she shall take the oath of affirmation prescribed by 28 U.S.C. §§ 453 and 631(g).
