**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
NO. 2026-08**

**PACER FEE EXEMPTION ORDER**

The Court received an application request by Jianbo Bin, for exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access fee schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts.

Jianbo Bin, a graduate student at the University of California San Diego, has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information. Accordingly, Jianbo Bin shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this Court, to the extent such use is incurred in the course of research to examine whether service providers/recordkeepers of 401(k) plans strategically influence the investment menu by limiting the inclusion of well-performing or low-fee unaffiliated funds relative to affiliated alternatives, and whether such menu design is associated with participant reallocations and subsequent Employee Retirement Income Security Act (“ERISA”) litigation. Jianbo Bin shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this Court. In addition, the following limitations apply:

1. this fee exemption applies only to Jianbo Bin (PACER Account #8914450) and is valid only for the purposes stated above;
2. this fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this Court that are available through the PACER system;
3. by accepting this exemption, Jianbo Bin agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption and not to redistribute any data over the internet;
4. this exemption is valid until March 31, 2027, unless earlier revoked.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center together with a copy of the application.
