In re Selection and Appointment of a Chief Pretrial Services Officer Under 18 U.S.C. Section 3152(c) ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER No. 99-9

The United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York having recommended to the Administrative Services Office of the United States Courts that a separate Pretrial Services Agency be established in said District under 18 U.S.C. Section 3152(c) to be administered by a Chief Pretrial Services Officer; and

Section 3152(c) of Title 18, United States Code, having required selection of a Chief Pretrial Services Officer by a panel consisting of the chief judge of the Circuit, the chief judge of the District, and a magistrate judge of the District or their designees; and

The Honorable Nina Gershon, having been selected as the designee of Chief Judge of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit Ralph K. Winter; and Philip Bigger, having been selected as the designee of Chief Judge of the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of New York Charles P. Sifton; and Magistrate Judge Viktor V. Pohorelsky having served as the panel; and the panel, following interviews, having selected Marion Gutmann as Chief Pretrial Services Office for the United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York; it is hereby

ORDERED that as of the 3rd day of January, 2000, the said Marion Gutmann, be and hereby is appointed Chief rretrial Services Officer for the Eastern District of New York.
